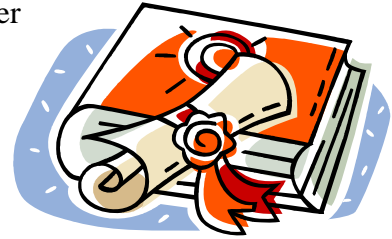


We will also be having an Art Gallery on that day. The children's art projects will be on display
